## OUR ETHOS

Education here is for life, not just the classroom. Our children leave us confident and well-mannered, with essential life skills such as the ability to interact with people and work as part of a team. These attributes are often noted by the head teachers of our destination schools.



Our academic achievements are high - yet we are much more than a place of preparation for examinations to destination schools. We believe a child's happiness and well-being is crucial to his or her academic success. Sevenoaks Prep provides a nurturing environment in which children can discover and develop their talents.







## **OUR SCHOOL**

Sevenoaks Prep welcomes girls and boys from 2 to 13 years of age. Our small class sizes and family atmosphere enables us to build warm relationships with the children and their parents.

Co-education and the continuity of education, from Nursery to Year 8, means family members can stay together, with girls and boys learning from each others' strengths. Our international families enrich life at The Prep.

The school was founded in 1919 and sits in approximately twenty five acres of beautiful grounds on the edge of Knole Park – a magnificent one thousand acre deer park and Site of Specific Scientific Interest owned by the National Trust.

This location is very important to us as it provides a useful and natural extension to our teaching facilities. Our environment also provides a vast playground, where children are trusted and encouraged to explore safely.

We have been fortunate to attract and retain an outstanding team of experienced, qualified teachers and support staff, committed to listening to you and your child and making your family's time with us as rewarding and fulfilling as possible.







## THE PRE-PREP: AGES 2 TO 7

The Pre-Prep is home to our younger pupils from Nursery to Year 2.

This is a crucial time in the life of children as they take their first steps towards independence. Their social and emotional needs are sensitively nurtured in a happy, secure environment. Nursery and Kindergarten are staffed by teachers and assistants who are specialists in Early Years education. There is a high teacher-to-pupil ratio and every child has a key worker.

The education provided is designed to match each child's needs, so that child-initiated play and teacher-directed activities are thoughtfully planned and carefully balanced. Full-time education starts in the Reception class. Staff provide a rich and stimulating environment where curiosity and enthusiasm to learn are fostered.

With class sizes small, pupils are assured personal attention and are motivated to achieve their best.

Apart from numeracy and literacy, many other subjects are taught in crosscurricular themes, often using topic work.

Our children are encouraged to present and perform to each other regularly in class and to parents in assemblies and concerts, helping to build their confidence and their communication skills. On entering the Prep School when they are seven years old, the vast majority of our children have attained a reading age significantly higher than the national average for their age. "Children trust and respect their teachers and relate well to each other. They are provided with secure foundations for their future well-being in all aspects of their learning. As a result, they respond to school life with great enthusiasm and enjoyment."

## THE PREP SCHOOL: AGES 7 TO 13

The Prep School is home to Years 3 to 8.

Class teaching is continued for core subjects, with specialist teaching for drama, French, music, ICT, PE and games. By the age of eleven, our pupils are taught by specialist teachers in all subjects whilst each class continues to have a form teacher who monitors their progress.

The curriculum is tailored to the needs of the pupils and their future aspirations. Whilst due regard is paid to the National Curriculum, our children are taught to the highest standard achievable by the individual. To this end, our teachers ensure that every pupil is motivated, challenged and prepared for examinations and scholarships to independent schools or 11+ or 13+ entry tests to local grammar schools.

As the children continue through the school they are offered opportunities for responsibility and leadership, which enable them to move on in life with confidence and purpose.















## EXTENSIVE CURRICULUM

Our extensive curriculum ensures that each pupil will find areas in which they excel. Alongside more traditional subjects like maths and English, we offer languages, ICT, art and design, drama, music and sport, all of which are integral to the life of the school. All classes participate in a regular programme of visits, workshops and field trips to support their learning. 13

## ACADEMIC SUCCESS

Our children feel challenged within a happy, diverse community of learners. The academic curriculum is enhanced by additional activities including debating and critical thinking.

Our pupils achieve excellent academic results and are successful in gaining entry into schools of their choice. Furthermore, a number of children are awarded academic, music, drama and sport scholarships to many leading senior independent schools including Tonbridge and Sevenoaks. Each year, our pupils gain places at grammar schools such as Judd, Cranbrook and Tonbridge Grammar.

We are proud to introduce pupils to their new schools, knowing that they have achieved their best and that they will make a significant contribution to life at their future school.









#### **ART & DESIGN**

Creativity and energetic self-expression are encouraged throughout the school. The work of various artists and designers is explored and enjoyment of the subject is as important as new skills.

#### DRAMA

#### MUSIC

In lessons taught by specialist staff from Nursery to Year 8, all children are encouraged to build a deeper appreciation of music. As well as group performances of various kinds – choirs, orchestras, ensembles and rock bands – individual tuition is offered in voice and in a wide range of instruments. Music is an integral part of school life.









#### **SPORT**

At Sevenoaks Prep sport is for all. We enjoy excellent facilities with many pitches, a hard court area and a magnificent hall. There is a comprehensive physical education curriculum, which begins in the Pre-Prep. Teams provide opportunities for all children to represent the school competitively in athletics, cricket, football, hockey, netball, rounders and rugby.

In addition, we offer an extensive range of clubs and extra-curricular activities at lunchtime and after school including fencing, judo and tennis.

## WORKING TOGETHER

Parents are kept up to date with their child's progress with formal meetings and written reports. In addition, staff are always available for parents to contact if they feel any matter needs their attention. This openness leads to plenty of discussion on how individual needs can be met.

Much of what we do is focused on preparing children for moving on. The Headmaster meets the parents of every child to create a personal plan for entry into senior education. Having no tied senior school, we can offer up to date, unbiased advice about the most suitable destination school for your child. The Headmaster is in constant communication with our destination schools to assess their suitability for our pupils.

Alumni and their parents regularly attend school events to continue their association with The Prep. The school grounds are used by past and present families during the weekends and holidays for picnics, cycling, games and other social and physical activities. There is an active alumni association and a development office which engage with past and present pupils, families and staff of the school.
